Wuskwatim Project Development Agreement Consultation Activities and Vote Information

Nisichawayasihk Cree Nation and Manitoba Hydro have completed negotiations on the Wuskwatim Project Development Agreement (PDA). If approved, the PDA will establish a partnership between NCN and Manitoba Hydro to build and operate a 200-megawatt hydroelectric generating station at Taskinigahp Falls on the Burntwood River. The PDA requires a majority yes vote by a majority of eligible NCN Members for the project to proceed.

NCN Chief and Council are hosting information events for NCN Members to ensure they are well informed before the Wuskwatim Project Development Agreement ratification vote.
