As you may recall, I am counsel to the Minister of Conservation with respect to the above-captioned appeal.

Further to my letter of October 6, 2006 with respect to the appeal procedure concerning Environment Act Licence No. 2700 (the "Licence"), I am writing to advise you that the Minister of Conservation has completed his review of your appeal of the Licence and, pursuant to clause 27(2)(d) of *The Environment Act*, proposed to dismiss your appeal.

In accordance with subsection 27(3) of *The Environment Act*, the Minister's proposed disposition of your appeal was referred to the Lieutenant in Council for approval. I have been informed by the Office of the Minister of Conservation that the Lieutenant Governor in Council approved the Minister's proposed disposition to dismiss your appeal of the Licence by an Order in Council that was passed at the meeting held on September 26, 2007.

For your information, each of the appellants' appeals of the Licence has been dismissed.
